TCT Virtual Pub Quiz

Structure

- Introduction: Welcome everyone to the quiz, inform them of the rules and give them 5 minutes to come up with a team name)
- 1st Round: Flag round Round of 10 questions. We can either put up a picture of the flag in question on the webcam or create a slideshow that has all of the flags on it and share the screen.
- **2**nd **Round:** Music round Round of 10 questions. 5 Album covers participants must guess, for last 5 questions participants must guess the lyrics. This is a double points round one for album/song and one for the artist.
- **3**rd **Round**: Each team must draw a picture of their team in isolation. Present your picture to the quiz master after the interval, the most creative picture will win!
- 15 minute break
- 4th Round: Link round 10 general knowledge questions. There will be one question at the end of the round asking the participants to guess the link between the previous 9 answers.
- 5th Round: Decade Round 10 questions on the previous decade.
- Final bonus 10 point Question: The team with the closest answer wins the 10 points.
- 10 minute break
- Winners announced

Rules

- Quiz master will be the sole marker of questions and will have full discretion on whether to award points or not.
- You must send your answers for the previous round to the quiz master at the end of each round. This can be done through a separate chat on which ever platform you may prefer, **make sure you do not send your answers to the other quiz participants.**
- You will find out the score tally after the end of each round
- There will be prizes for 1st place, 2nd place, best name and and the best isolation picture drawn.
- Each round will have 10 questions.


