

FAQ's – Surrey Hills Hike 2023

How do I register to take part in the walk?

What is the cost to enter to the walk?

The entry fee is £10 per adult (16+) and £5 per child (2-16). Under 2s can attend for free.

Is there a fundraising target for this walk?

There is no set minimum target for this event. However, individuals who fundraise over £150, and families and groups who raise over £250, will be invited back on-site for a thank-you event.

What time does the walk start?

We will be using a wave system on the day to ensure numbers are properly managed. The time on your ticket will determine the start time of the walk and the first wave will head off between 9:30 and 10:30.

Can I change which distance I want to walk once I have registered?

Is the walk accessible?

You need to be of a certain fitness to participate in the 5- and 10-miles route. These routes are not appropriate for buggies and wheelchairs.

This year, we have a new '1k Your Way' route that will also start and finish at The Children's Trust and go around the residential roads of Tadworth. This is a fully accessible route for wheelchairs, buggies, mobility scooters etc.

Can I bring my own food and drink?

Yes, you can. There will also be a refreshment station along the route.

Are dogs welcome?

Yes, dogs are very welcome to take part too! We would just ask that you keep your dog on a lead, at the start and finish of the event, when you are onsite at The Children's Trust. We also ask that you are a responsible dog owner and pick up any mess along the way.

What will I receive when I cross the finish line at the end of the walk?

All participants will receive a medal and a very big cheer!

Will there be parking available?

There is no parking onsite, but you will be able to park on local roads in the vicinity of The Children's Trust site. Please respect our local residents when parking your vehicle.
